



Abstract Submission Instructions

1. The abstract text must be **300 words or less** (not including title and authors' information.) This should include a clear purpose or objective, the main points you wish to communicate, the outcomes and results, and how your presentation will benefit symposium participants. Please note that the webform will not allow you to save an abstract that is longer than 300 words.

Abstracts must be related to your RNAO guideline implementation and one of the two symposium themes:

- · Using BPSO to advance equity, diversity and inclusion
- · BPSO public visibility and outcomes
- 2. The abstract can be submitted in ONLY ONE of the following presentation preference types:
 - Concurrent paper presentation: Presenters share the details of their accepted abstract in a 20 minute presentation (15-minute oral presentation & 5-minute Q & A.)
 - Rapid oral: Presenters share the details of their accepted abstract in a rapid 7 minute presentation (5-minute presentation, leaving 2 minutes for Q & A.)

*The planning committee reserves the right to reclassify submitted abstracts into the most appropriate presentation type and theme.

- 3. Abstracts are to be submitted in English.
- 4. Only fully completed presenter profiles and abstract submissions (marked as final) will be reviewed (please make sure to submit all "Draft" abstracts before the deadline!)
- 5. A maximum of six co-authors may submit a joint abstract. Up to two attendees per BPSO will be permitted to attend the symposium in-person, which would include the presenter(s). See your BPSO Agreement for details on funding, if applicable.
- 6. Applicants will be notified by Monday, Sept. 9, 2024 if their abstract has been accepted.

Tips: Steps to assist BPSOs in developing an abstract



Gather ideas

- What are you most proud of?
- Brainstorm with your team and write them down



Match your ideas with the conference theme

 Use key words and language from the conference call for abstracts





Review the submission guidelines

- Follow the word count
- Address any specific items e.g., learning goals, methods, outcomes



Understand your target audience

- Engage the reader
- Highlight the impact and outcomes



Create an engaging story

- Be concise and informative
- What is your hook?
- What is new and interesting to share?

Other tips:

- ✓ Include references in your abstract if possible
- √ Have someone review it before submitting
- Be BOLD!
